NOTIFICATION

- i. The Federal Government vide SRO(1)/2001 dated 14th September, 2006 and in exercise of the powers conferred by clause (a) of Section 2 of the Price Control & Prevention and Hoarding Act, 1977 (XXXIX of 1977), has authorized the officers specified below to exercise the powers of Controller-General of Prices and Supplies under clause (a) of sub-section (2) of section 3 of ibid Act, within their respective jurisdiction:
 - a. Secretary Industries & Commerce Department
 - b. Director Industries, Provincial Government
 - c. All District Coordination Officers/ DCs
- ii. All dealers dealing with sugar business are required to get their dealership registered in the office of respective Deputy Commissioner (District of consumption) except Quetta, where sugar dealers will get themselves registered with Director General Industries and Commerce. Any other unregistered sugar business is liable to be seized.
- iii. In order to meet the requirement of local consumption and genuineness of dealership before seizure, confirmation of the concerned DC/ Directorate of Industries & Commerce (Destination District) to be obtained.
- iv. Dealers of sugar are required to invariably report the number and location of their shops, sale points, warehouses / godowns and plots etc. in Balochistan, and report the same to the concerned Department.
- v. After establishment of web portal, all supplies of sugar consignments inbound to districts of Balochistan shall be considered un-authorize/illegal /un-fair trade if the truck/vehicle carrying sugar is not reported to the concerned Department's Web Portal and / or does not have proper documentation such as NOC from the concerned Department, Sales Tax paid invoice, name and address of dealer or warehouse etc, to prove its disposal at destination. Similarly, no vehicle / carrier shall be allowed movement of consignments of sugar in Balochistan, even if reported on the portal, and there is no mention of destination / location on invoice of the goods.
- vi. Similarly, all other supplies of sugar from the sugar mills should be shipped into Balochistan by sugar mills/ dealers, with proper documentation such as Sales Tax paid invoice of the company, name and address of dealer or reported warehouse, sale point, warehouse turnout report, signed stamps of the Track and Trace department of Inland Revenue Service, FBR, especially designed for tracking the sugar consignments etc. to prove its legal disposal at destination that too with proper certification issued by the concerned Department.
- vii. The shipment of sugar purchased from dealers of other provinces viz, Sind, Punjab and KPK by sugar businessmen of Balochistan, for sale among the dealers in the bordering districts of Sind, Punjab and KPK not reported on Web Portal will only be allowed if such transaction is acknowledged by the Department/ District Administration, through issuance of NOC.



- viii. Movement of sugar within districts of Balochistan by dealers of sugar will only be allowed with prior recommendation of the concerned officer of the Industries and Commerce Department at district level in the form of No Objection Certificate. Sugar being transported by the sugar mills or the dealers without NOC from the Industries Department shall be liable to seizure.
 - ix. The seized quantities of sugar shall be dealt as per Customs laws.
 - x. The District Administrations in consultation with the Industries and Commerce Department shall assess / quantify the requirement of each district and shall also carry out track and traceability operation in their respective districts to ensure proper utilization of sugar in their respective districts.
 - xi. Sugar companies / businessmen and dealers shall be bound to report their inventories, stored quantity in shops, warehouses, storage areas and plots, invoices and details of purchasers etc. to the District Administration and Industries and Commerce Department.
 - xii. The concerned staff of the District Administration and the Industries and Commerce Department shall act accordingly to the Price Control & Prevention and Hoarding Act, 1977, if there is reason to believe that in such place huge quantity of sugar is stored for illegal / unfair trade.
- xiii. Without prejudice to the generality of all above and keeping in view the peculiar circumstances of Balochistan sugar dealers shall be afforded opportunity of personal hearing before formal seizure of sugar.
- This SOP should be followed by all organizations and departments concerned with monitoring sugar supplies, controlling unfair trade, overpricing, hoarding, profiteering and smuggling of sugar, in Balochistan.
- 3. All Departments in para 2 shall be in contact with Industries & Commerce to implement decisions of Sugar Advisory Board (SAB), issued from time to time.

This is issued with the prior approval of the Controller General of Prices and Supplies.
